





Transfer iPhone transactions to EweManage



Step 1 (on the iPhone)
Create the transaction files on your phone

a) Once you have new transactions the “Export” button becomes visible



Step 2 (at the PC)
Transfer those files to the PC by mail

a) Click on the Export button
b) Enter your mail address and “Send”



The appropriate files created (here lambings) are Emailed to your mailbox)

Step 3 (at the PC)
Copy the files on the PC and confirm transactions in EweManage


A) In EweManage click on Readers/scale button
Select “Mobile PC EweManage”



B) Copy (save) the Emailed files into the folder you have defined earlier (See Hint - bottom left of this page)



C) Select the proper “import” transaction (green Button) in the import menu



D) Confirm the new transactions into EweManage



Hint: You may want to configure the location of your files (Browse button) directly into iCloud drive to skip some copy/paste steps









Transfer EweManage data to your iPhone



This procedure requires that you have an iCloud account access on your PC

Make sure that you have no new non-exported transactions in your phone prior to importing the data

Step 1 (at the PC) Create the files containing EweManage information	Step 2 (on the iPhone) Copy the data files created into your iCloud account	Step 3 (on the iPhone) Import (read) the EweManage data into the iPhone
<p>a) Access the reader/scale button and select « Mobile PC EweManage »</p>  <p>If not already done, determine (once) where you want EweManage to put the data files to export to the mobile</p>  <p>Click "Browse to select" (see Hint page 1)</p> <p>b) In the "export" section, click "Export All" and then "IOS" mode</p>  <p>7 data files are Created of type .fmpur</p>	<p>A) On your iPhone, Launch Filemaker Go</p>  <p>B) Bottom of screen, click My Device</p>  <p>then the iCloud icon - top left of screen</p>  <p>C) Download the 7 data files (.fmpur) by "tapping" on each one</p> 	<p>A) Open the Mobile_PC application</p>  <p>B) go to the 3rd screen of the application and click import All</p>  <p>C) Once completed, you may verify that everything has been imported by clicking the List/Find button</p>
